**Description:** This unique certificate program is designed for Professionals who will be key Assistive Technology (AT) Assessors or persons currently in positions as AT Assessors in districts or SELPAs. It is designed to be comparable to a graduate university course (units are available at an additional fee).

***This AT Certificate program includes thorough instruction and exercises on how to assess and support students with curriculum and physical access needs. Participants will demonstrate the following learning outcomes:***

**LEARNING OUTCOMES**

- Demonstrate understanding of the range and uses of low/medium technology for high incidence and physically handicapped students.
- Demonstrate understanding and appropriate application of software & apps for word prediction, screen reading, text to speech, internet access & organization.
- Demonstrate understanding of Special Education Law as it relates to Assistive Technology for curriculum access.
- Demonstrate the ability to assess AT needs of students to gain access to the curriculum by satisfactorily completing TWO *Legally Defensible* AT Assessment Projects
- Demonstrate the ability to integrate student curriculum and AT accommodations with various teaching styles and individual student needs.

## The AT Certification Program meets the needs of two distinct audiences.

1. **AT Specialist Certificate Participants** Professionals who will be key Assistive Technology (AT) Assessors or persons currently in positions as AT Assessors in districts or SELPAs. This course is for you if -- you would like to be able to do AT Assessments, write reports of findings, and handle litigious IEP meetings.

**Regular Registration \$2,600 after December 21, 2019**

**(University units are paid at the end of the course directly to Brandman University \$210 for 3 units.)**

2. **Non-certificate** (University units not available)
